

KIOSK SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

1.) Insert the black Allen key into the hole at the top left of the kiosk enclosure and hold down until the screen comes on.



- 2.) Swipe up on the screen and enter the KioskSimple Limited password: KS2015Pwd!
- 3.) Tap on the internet/WiFi icon at the bottom right hand of the screen.



<u>*VERY Important* – Please make sure you select "Connect Automatically" when choosing your WiFi network.</u>

5.) Once connected to WiFi, Double tap on "Start Kiosk Simple"



6.) Tap the red text that says "Lockdown Kiosk" and then tap YES.

- 5.) You can then power off the kiosk using the black Allen key provided, or the Windows button in the bottom left corner.
